**FROM THE PASTOR'S STUDY**

## **FOR AN ETERNAL IMPACT**

When I was a teenager in the mid-late 1990's, our church had been going through an exciting spark of evangelism. Our youth group would go to local parks, most notably West Park, in the city of Pittsburgh and put on outreach events. The outreaches consisted of us bringing food, music and dancing, then giving a gospel message. Several people accepted Jesus during these times. It was so exciting to see lives change from events that God led us to lead.

One summer Sunday afternoon, myself and a handful of other youth group peers wanted to do another outreach in downtown. Our venue would be the Pittsburgh Civic Arena. There was a concert held on this particular night headlined by the wildly controversial goth rock band Marilyn Manson. We teens met at our church and prayed for about an hour, grabbed some Bibles and went downtown ready to share the good news of Jesus.

There were security concerns about the crowd at this concert so the entry way in to the arena was single-file through one gate. Needless to say there was a long line which was perfect for us because we had a captive audience.

My friends and I split up into pairs and began talking with people in line about Jesus. We had several conversations that afternoon. Most people were not interested in what we were talking about. Some people were hostile towards us and our message, but there were a few that were willing to hear us out. We spoke to at least 100 people that day about Jesus.

One young teenager dressed in complete gothic attire was listening to the message of Jesus' love for him. As I began to share of how God the father loved him so much that He sent Jesus to die for his sins, tears started to flow down his face ruining his black make-up. This boy shared that he was never told that he was loved by any one and that this music and garb was the only time he felt accepted. He gave his life to Jesus right there. Then he composed himself and grabbed me by the arm insisting that we tell everyone we could about the Jesus who just saved him

On a Sunday afternoon in June of 1990 something, a life was changed. Someone's eternal destiny had been rerouted to Heaven.

Sometimes I am tempted to look at numbers to measure success. If I had used percentages to gauge the effectiveness of our time sharing the gospel, the day would be considered a massive failure. Two (a security worker also accepted Jesus that day) out of about one hundred is not a positive rate. Instead of using some number metric for eternal success rate, we looked at these two lives that are forever changed. It is a simple reminder that God wants us to give the gospel to all the world, but look for the ONE who needs to hear it. There are people ready to hear about Jesus. Let's obey the words of Jesus and GO.

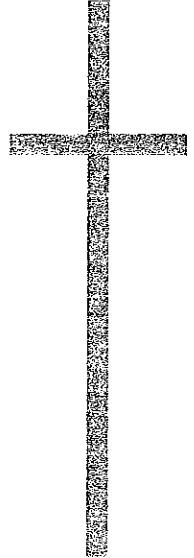
